Through its integrated business model, comprising racing and racecourse entertainment, a membership club, responsible sports wagering and lottery, and charities and community contribution, the Club generates economic and social value for the community and supports the Government in combatting illegal gambling. The Club is Hong Kong's largest single taxpayer and its Charities Trust is one of the world's top ten charity donors.



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Philanthropy for Better Cities Forum 2023

Philanthropy for Fairer Societies

Global wealth inequality is widening, showing no signs of respite. Since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020, the world's richest 1% captured 67% of all new wealth. At the same time, we are seeing inflation outpacing wage growth, technological innovation driving wholesale changes to traditional job roles, climate change disproportionately impacting the vulnerable, and rapid urbanisation creating more uneven distribution of resources. These trends are exacerbating an already challenging scenario, leading to unfair economic and social development as well as frustration and discontent across generations.

The quest for fairer societies is not new, but it is now a globally interconnected quest. It is a global challenge that requires collective action and collaboration across borders. This calls for significant innovation in existing social systems and flexibility to adapt or create new institutions that drive towards fairer societies. It also calls for deeper global dialogue that values and learns from both the East and the West, and calls for us to reflect on different models of doing good through philanthropy.

Philanthropy, while small in terms of overall resource mobilisation, has enjoyed the largest degree of latitude to drive innovation and help build the linkages and institutions of tomorrow. Its capital is flexible, less risk-averse and not nearly as beholden to expectations of markets or political cycles. The world has seen how the flexible, innovative, and catalytic nature of philanthropy can plug gaps in the socioeconomic ecosystem and how philanthropy can take a significant role in tackling the most challenging social issues in cross-sectoral collaboration with different actors.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust is committed to supporting and advancing this agenda, and is pleased to once again host the **Philanthropy for Better Cities Forum** ("the Forum") with the overarching theme: **Philanthropy for Fairer Societies** this September.

The Forum aims to convene discussion and debates among philanthropic, academic, business, social sector and government leaders that reimagine new service models, ultimately striving towards fairness of opportunities and outcomes, and exploring how 21st-century philanthropies could evolve in Asia and beyond.

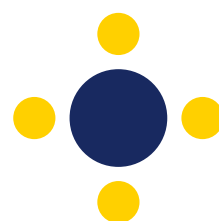
全球財富不均狀況持續加劇，一直未見緩和。自2020年新冠疫情爆發以來，全球最富裕的1%人口佔據所有新增財富的67%；與此同時，通脹上升超越工資的增長、科技創新引致傳統工作角色的全面變革、氣候變化對弱勢社群帶來嚴重影響，急速城市化也加劇資源分配失衡。這些現象加深了社會目前所面臨的挑戰，導致經濟和社會發展不平等，亦令不同世代感到焦慮和不安。

追求更能惠及不同群體的社會並非新議題，更成了當今全世界的共同目標。要達成這個目標，跨地域行動和協作是不可或缺的要素。這不僅需要革新現存的社會制度，給予彈性去改變或建立新的機制去推動更平等的社會；同時亦要各方透過更深入的全球對話，汲取東西方的經驗，思索各種公益慈善服務的模式。

儘管公益慈善事業在整體資源調動中佔比不大，卻擁有最大的空間去推動創新、支援可持續機構及連結未來。公益慈善事業的資本靈活、具風險承擔能力，並且幾乎不受市場預期或政治周期的影響。世界各地不同例子已展示了公益慈善事業的靈活、創新和催化度，它不單能填補社會經濟體系中的需求，亦可於解決跨界合作難題上發揮顯著作用。

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金致力支持及推動這項議程，以及很榮幸在今年九月再次舉辦**香港國際慈善論壇**（「論壇」），主題為「**攜手公益 普惠社群**」。

論壇旨在為慈善、學術、商業、社福及政府領袖提供討論及辯論的平台，重新構想嶄新的服務模式，積極實現共享的機遇和成果，並探討21世紀公益慈善事業在亞洲及其他地區的發展路向。

Founded in 1884, we are a world-class horse racing club that acts continuously for the betterment of Hong Kong society. The Club's unique integrated business model generates economic and social value through racing, racecourse entertainment, sports wagering and lottery with surplus revenues channeled to the Club's Charities Trust. The Charities Trust makes a positive impact on communities all across Hong Kong and is one of the world's top ten charity donors.

In 2022/23 alone we contributed a record HK\$35.9 billion (US\$4.6 billion), including HK\$7.3 billion (US\$940 million) in approved charity donations.

香港賽馬會成立於1884年，是致力建設更美好社會的世界級賽馬機構。我們以獨特的綜合營運模式，透過結合賽馬及馬場娛樂、有節制體育博彩和獎券，創造經濟及社會價值，並將經營盈餘撥捐慈善信託基金。基金為香港社會謀求長遠福祉，同時是全球十大慈善捐助機構之一。

單在2022/23財政年度，馬會的社會貢獻便達到359億港元(約46億美元)，創歷史新高，當中包括73億港元(約9.4億美元)的已審批慈善捐款。

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金

The Club can trace its long tradition of donating to charitable causes back to at least 1915, but it was in the 1950s, as Hong Kong struggled to cope with post-war reconstruction and a massive influx of immigrants, that this role became integral to its operation. In 1955, the Club formally decided to devote its surplus each year to charity and community projects, and in 1959, a separate company, the Hong Kong Jockey Club (Charities) Ltd, was formed to administer donations. In 1993, a new entity was established, The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, to reflect the evolving nature, scale and scope of donations. The Charities Trust is one of the world's top ten charity donors.

The Trust's substantial donations to the community are made possible by the Club's unique integrated business model, which comprises racing and racecourse entertainment, responsible sports wagering and lottery, a membership club, and charities and community contribution. Approximately 90% of the Club's annual operating surplus after tax is donated to the Trust, enabling it to play a significant role in the community's development.

Working with the Government, non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and community partners, the Trust is committed to improving the quality of life of the people of Hong Kong. As a philanthropic organisation in its own right, the Trust also proactively identifies and initiates projects that anticipate future community and social needs.

Our contributions help fulfil the needs of people from all walks of life, across 5 distinct categories of social need:

馬會早於1915年或以前，已開始捐助社會公益。至五十年代，香港面對戰後重建、大量移民湧入等棘手問題，促使馬會將慈善業務納入業務範圍。1955年，馬會正式決定將每年盈餘撥捐慈善及公益項目。1959年，馬會設立另一家公司，名為香港賽馬會(慈善)有限公司，專責管理捐款事務；鑑於有關事務發展一日千里，香港賽馬會慈善信託基金遂於1993年成立，接管馬會的捐款事宜。香港賽馬會慈善信託基金是全球十大慈善捐助機構之一。

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金得以大額捐款資助社區項目，全賴馬會獨特的營運模式，結合賽馬及馬場娛樂、會員會所、有節制體育博彩及獎券，以及慈善與社區貢獻。馬會每年將約90%的稅後經營盈餘撥捐慈善信託基金，多年來於社區發展擔當重要角色。

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金致力與政府、非政府組織及社區機構攜手改善港人生活質素。此外，基金主動適時開展項目，回應社會長遠發展所需。

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金對民生及社會的貢獻全面，主要覆蓋下列五個慈善策略範疇：



公益慈善研究院 Institute of Philanthropy

The Hong Kong Jockey Club has a rich history of giving back, particularly during the city's most challenging hours, with its first charitable donations dating from as early as 1915. For over a century, we have witnessed how philanthropy, embedded in the Club's integrated business model, has positively responded to the ever-changing social, economic and welfare needs of Hong Kong, bringing hope to the people and bettering society. In partnership with our non-governmental organisation grantees, we have learned the synergistic power of collaboration to create greater and longer-lasting impact for our beneficiaries.

This legacy has presented an exceptional opportunity for the Club to establish the Institute of Philanthropy (IoP), a “think-fund-do” tank dedicated to promoting philanthropic thought leadership at the local, regional and global levels together with its funder partners.

Rooted in the East for the World

Grounded in the East, the IoP acknowledges Asia's growing importance in the global philanthropic ecosystem. As the demand for philanthropic knowledge and competencies rises with economic growth and development, the IoP aims to provide a convening platform for fellow foundations to promote the common good for societies everywhere.

We have earmarked an initial sum of HK\$5 billion to fulfil our mission of becoming a “think-fund-do” tank for China and Asia.

Vision

Working towards the betterment of societies everywhere through impactful philanthropy

Mission

As a global “think-fund-do” tank anchored in the East, we will:

- Bridge regional and global philanthropic efforts for the greater good.
- Scale strategic and innovative solutions to address regional and global challenges.
- Accelerate the professionalisation of the philanthropic sector.

Our work will focus on:

Connecting and Convening: We will build a platform that brings together thought leaders, philanthropists and key stakeholders to learn and exchange philanthropic best practices; in addition we will actively engage in local, regional and global events to bridge stakeholders across different spectra and levels all round the world.

Synthesising and Sharing: We will bring together fellow foundations and other institutions through various means, such as joint publications and case studies, to consolidate and disseminate knowledge, as well as co-create and co-fund projects.

Building Professional Capacities: We will develop programmes to enhance the skills and capacities of professionals in the philanthropic and non-profit sectors. This includes strengthening the philanthropic industry, particularly in Hong Kong and other Greater Bay Area cities, by establishing industry-wide infrastructure and standards in areas like professional grant making, outcome-based funding, and impact measurement.

Commissioning and Supporting Research: We will collaborate with leading universities, institutes, foundations, think tanks and philanthropic stakeholders to conduct and commission research around issues pertinent to the sector.

Institute of Philanthropy

公益慈善研究院

憑藉過百年的公益慈善實踐經驗及與非政府組織的緊密協作，我們見證了各界合作的協同力量，能夠創造更大且持續的正面影響。有見及此，馬會全力推動成立公益慈善研究院，透過結合「智、善、行」（智慧、善款、行動），致力鞏固夥伴合作，在地方、區域及全球層面增強公益慈善思想領導力。

植根東方，面向國際

公益慈善研究院立足東方，堅信亞洲將在全球公益慈善中擔當更重要角色。近年亞洲經濟顯著增長，對公益慈善知識與能力需求日殷，研究院旨在為業界構建交流平台，以促進社會共同福祉。

馬會將撥款50億港元作為研究院的初始基金，結合「智、善、行」，為中國以至全亞洲的公益慈善事業作出貢獻。

實踐研究院的使命，我們主要工作包括：

召集與連繫：搭建平台，匯聚業界思想領袖、公益慈善家等主要持份者，交流和學習公益慈善領域的最佳實踐經驗，促進世界各地不同階層公益慈善持份者的連繫；

整合與傳播：通過各種方式，如聯名出版、案例研究、聯合策動和捐助項目等，整合及傳播公益慈善領域的最佳實踐及影響力；

提升專業能力：制定方案，提升公益慈善和非牟利機構專業人員的技巧和能力；通過各方面基礎和標準設置，例如專業撥款、成果導向捐助策略及影響力評估等，提升各地（特別是本港及其他大灣區城市）公益慈善發展的專業水平；

委託及開展研究：與頂尖大學、院校、基金會、智庫和業界持份者合作，圍繞公益慈善界別共同關注的議題開展研究及委託研究。

Message from the Chairman of The Hong Kong Jockey Club 香港賽馬會主席獻辭



We're back – and in stronger shape than ever! After an unscripted five-year hiatus forced upon us by the pandemic, I am excited to welcome you all to Philanthropy for Better Cities 2023 (“PBC Forum”).

Our inaugural PBC Forum in 2016, and our second in 2018, were convened with the prime objectives of establishing cross-sectoral dialogue on the social issues confronting urban populations, especially in Asia, and exploring the potential of philanthropy to address these issues by catalysing change and driving innovation.

I believe these two key objectives have not only been met, but exceeded. The PBC Forum and its associated Foundations Circle have become firmly established as a premier meeting point for philanthropic foundations, family offices, NGOs, academics and others to exchange ideas, experiences and best practices – the only gathering of its type in Asia, and one of the largest anywhere. This year we have more than 1,600 delegates joining us from around the world, including close to 70 eminent speakers and over 200 representatives of regional and global foundations. This impressive meeting of minds offers us a unique opportunity to address some of the most intractable challenges facing 21st century cities and explore how we can best work together for the betterment of society.

At The Hong Kong Jockey Club, however, we are always looking to do still more – and in particular, to ensure that this philanthropic thought power is not constrained by two-year intervals but harnessed into a continuous partnership. That is why we are now establishing the Institute of Philanthropy (“IoP”), which will be formally inaugurated at this year's PBC Forum, backed by a very significant endowment from the Club. We see the IoP as far more than either a think-tank or a new funding mechanism; our aim is to make it a “think-fund-do” organisation that can proactively make strategic grants and help the philanthropy sector build capacity, contributing to local, national and regional development alike. It will consolidate and share best practices, act as a networking agent, and spur professional development in the philanthropic sector.

Since our last PBC Forum in 2018, the pandemic and its economic aftermath have impacted all of us – but sadly some much more than others. By choosing the theme “Philanthropy for Fairer Societies” for this year's Forum, we want to address some of the inequalities that societies face today, exacerbated by the restrictions of the past three years which in particular have affected healthcare, education and social services, often turning existing societal gaps into chasms. How can we now narrow these chasms and start restoring fairness, justice and hope to all? While we cannot expect to find all the answers in the next two days, my hope is that we can leave with new directions, new drive and new determination.

I should like to thank the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region for its continued support, as well as our many partners in Hong Kong and internationally. Most of all I would like to thank our speakers and delegates. I sincerely hope you will find the next two days inspiring and productive.

本人謹代表香港賽馬會，歡迎各位參加2023香港國際慈善論壇。論壇受疫情影響闊別五年，如今載譽歸來，將會較以往更盛況空前。

香港國際慈善論壇於2016年創辦，第二屆於2018年舉行。首兩屆論壇的目標致力於建立跨界別交流平台，討論城市人口面臨的種種社會議題，特別是針對亞洲地區；以及探討慈善事業如何透過推動變革創新，協助應對這些議題，作出貢獻。

本人相信這兩項目標不僅已經實現，而且超額完成。香港國際慈善論壇及相關的「公益慈善基金會」會議已發展成為世界級的交流平台，讓各地慈善基金會、家族辦公室、非政府機構和學者等聚首一堂，分享真知灼見及最佳實踐經驗。論壇亦是亞洲唯一的同類型活動，規模媲美其他地區的大型慈善會議。今年的論壇有超過1,600名來自世界各地的代表出席，包括近70名知名講者，以及200多位亞太區和國際基金會代表。與會者將於論壇舉行期間，討論如何應對二十一世紀城市所面臨的一些挑戰，並探討如何攜手並肩，共同建設更美好社會。

香港賽馬會一直努力不懈，務求精益求精。為了確保論壇營造的慈善思維力量能夠轉化成持續發展的合作夥伴關係，不受每隔兩年舉辦一次的模式限制，馬會於今屆論壇正式公佈成立「公益慈善研究院」，並為研究院作出重大撥款。對馬會而言，研究院不止是一個智庫或嶄新的捐助機制。馬會的願景是要將研究院發展成為一個集「智、善、行」(智慧、善款、行動)於一身的機構，讓其能夠主動開展策略性捐助項目，也可在香港、國家，以至地區層面上，協助提升慈善業界水平。研究院亦會整合及分享業界的最佳實踐經驗，以及提供一個聯繫交流的平台，致力推動慈善業界的專業發展。

自上一屆論壇於2018年舉行後，疫情的爆發導致世界各地的經濟大受影響，其中部分社群所受到的影響更為嚴重。今年論壇以「攜手公益 普惠社群」為主題，旨在聚焦社會目前面臨的若干不平等情況，特別是過去三年，疫情下種種限制措施對醫療、教育及社會服務構成影響，令貧富懸殊的情況愈見嚴重。我們應如何縮窄這些鴻溝，為受影響的人士創造一個更公平、更有希望的前景？雖然為期兩天的論壇未必能夠提出所有問題的解決方案，本人期望論壇能為各與會者帶來新的方向、動力和決心。

本人衷心感謝香港特別行政區政府對是次論壇的持續支持，並向馬會的本地和海外合作夥伴，以及論壇所有講者和與會代表致謝。在此祝願大家在連兩日的論壇中能夠獲益良多，有所啟發。

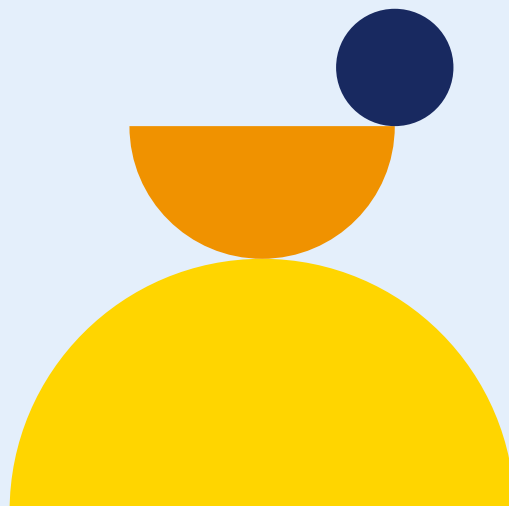

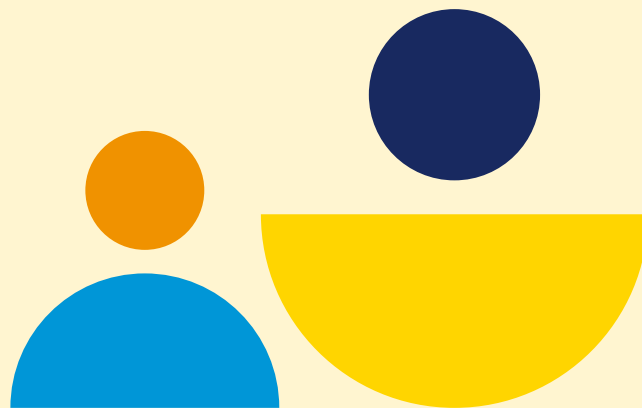

Balancing economic growth and equity goals

Over the last century, economic growth has delivered much of the world out of poverty. For some of that time, growth came hand in hand with increased income equality and more equitable access to services. But that relationship has at various points broken down, especially since the turn of the century. For most countries, modern growth has seemed to necessitate high levels of inequality. Is this truly a by-product or a choice? Can we improve the 'quality' and 'equity' and not simply the 'quantum' of our growth?

In this opening session, Professor Abhijit Banerjee will draw on his life's work to dissect patterns behind the wealth of nations, and what philanthropies could do for the ones who are left behind. It will set the scene for the overall conference with each subsequent session exploring different levers for achieving a more equitable society.

在過去一世紀，世界不少地方因受益於經濟增長而脫離窮困。社會大眾收入的提升和共享服務權利的擴大更一度並軌前行。然而在本世紀初，兩者似乎漸行漸遠。時至今天，財富不均的現象在大多數國家在經濟的高速發展下不斷加劇。「不平等」是經濟騰飛的副產品？抑或是一種選擇？我們能否著眼於追求「質」和「公平」的躍升而非「量」的積累？

為是次論壇掀開序幕的Abhijit Banerjee教授，將傾注畢生研究，對國家財富背後的模式剖毫析芒，同時他將分享公益慈善事業該如何幫助弱勢社群。論壇的其他環節也將以此為軸，深度探討如何向更公平的社會邁進。



Abhijit BANERJEE

2019 Nobel Laureate in Economics and Ford Foundation International Professor of Economics, Massachusetts Institute of Technology
2019諾貝爾經濟學獎得主及麻省理工學院福特基金會國際經濟學教授

Abhijit Vinayak Banerjee is the 2019 Nobel Prize in Economics recipient along with his wife, Esther Duflo, and Michael Kremer. He was educated at the University of Calcutta, Jawaharlal Nehru University and Harvard University, where he received his Ph.D in 1988.

In 2003 he founded the Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL), along with Esther Duflo and Sendhil Mullainathan, and he remains one of the lab's directors.

Abhijit Banerjee is a past president of the Bureau for the Research in the Economic Analysis of Development, a Research Associate of the NBER, a CEPR research fellow, International Research Fellow of the Kiel Institute, a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the Econometric Society, and has been a Guggenheim Fellow and an Alfred P. Sloan Fellow and a winner of the Infosys prize.

He is the author of a large number of articles and four books, including *Poor Economics*, which won the Goldman Sachs Business Book of the Year. Abhijit's newest book, co-authored with Esther Duflo, titled *Good Economics for Hard Times*, is on how economics can help us solve social and political problems of our day. He is the editor of three more books and has directed two documentary films.

He also served on the U.N. Secretary-General's High-level Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda.

Abhijit Vinayak Banerjee在2019年與妻子Esther Duflo及美國學者Michael Kremer共同獲頒諾貝爾經濟學獎。他畢業於加爾各答大學、尼赫魯大學，並在1988年獲得哈佛大學博士學位。

2003年，他與Esther Duflo及Sendhil Mullainathan共同成立Abdul Latif Jameel「扶貧行動實驗室」(J-PAL)，至今仍為實驗室主任之一。

Abhijit Banerjee曾任發展經濟分析與研究局主席、美國國家經濟研究局(NBER)以及經濟政策研究中心研究員，同時也是Kiel研究所的國際研究員，以及美國文理科學院與世界計量經濟學會院士。他亦是Guggenheim院士、Alfred P. Sloan院士，以及Infosys獎獲獎者。

他發表過不少文章，亦出版過四本書籍，其中包括榮獲高盛年度商業書籍的《窮人的經濟學》。最新與Esther Duflo合著的《艱困時代的經濟學思考》，講述經濟發展如何幫助解決現今社會和政治問題。他是另外三本書的編輯，並是兩部紀錄片的導演。

他曾擔任聯合國秘書長「2015年後發展議程」(Post-2015 Development Agenda)小組成員。

Professor Richard Wong is Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Philip Wong Kennedy Wong Professor in Political Economy at The University of Hong Kong. He is active in advancing research on economic policy studies in Hong Kong and China through his work as founding Director of the Hong Kong Centre for Economic Research since 1987.

His research includes public housing, household economics, informal labor markets, and regional economic development in China.

He had served on a number of public bodies in Hong Kong and is currently a member of the Chief Executive's Policy Unit Expert Group.

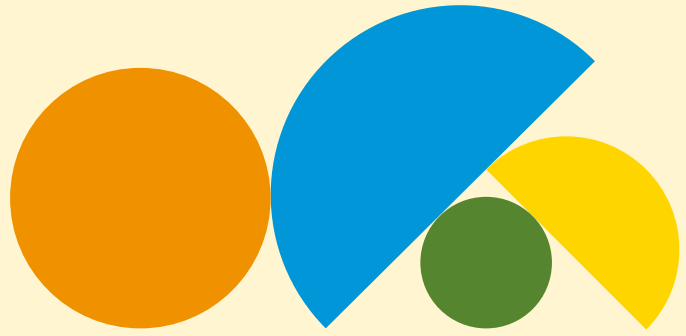
He was awarded the Silver Bauhinia Star in 1999 by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region in recognition of his contributions to education, housing, and industry and technology development. He was appointed a Justice of the Peace in 2000.

王于漸教授現為香港大學首席副校長及黃乾亨黃英豪政治經濟學教授。王教授於1987及1999年先後創立香港經濟研究中心及香港經濟及商業策略研究所，透過其工作推動有關香港經濟政策問題研究；亦曾於《信報》及《南華早報》撰寫每週政經評論專欄；並出版了《香港深層次矛盾》、《香港長遠房屋策略和港人港地》、《香港奇跡已經幻滅？》、《面對不均再創奇蹟》等書。

他目前的研究重點是關於產業、房屋、勞動力和人口的政治經濟。

王教授現為特首政策組研究策略專家組之成員；曾歷任多個政府委員會的委員，包括香港特別行政區政府外匯基金諮詢委員會、醫院管理局、行政長官創新科技委員會及房屋委員會等。

王教授於1999年獲香港特別行政區政府頒贈銀紫荊星章，以表揚他對香港教育、房屋、工業及科技發展所作出的貢獻，於2000年獲委任為太平紳士。

The COVID-19 pandemic revealed global unpreparedness to effectively respond to a crisis of such magnitude. It exposed cracks in our systems in terms of essential stockpiles, domestic and international coordination, public health machinery, among others. With climate change, unplanned urbanisation, and population growth, ever more people will now be exposed to complex disasters. With an eye on this future, “failure to prepare means preparing to fail.” Collaboration across sectors, organisations, and areas of expertise emerged as a distinguishing factor for the jurisdictions that managed COVID-19 better than others. Should the philanthropic sector launch mechanisms for collective action to build greater resilience?

This session aims to explore the potential of global philanthropic collaboration to prevent and prepare for future public health crises and discuss opportunities for strategic action.

新冠疫情揭示全球各地在應對大規模危機方面的準備不足，揭示了現有制度的問題，尤其是所需儲備、本地和國際之間的協調不足、公共衛生系統等方面的問題。隨著氣候變化、急速城市化和人口增長，世界各地勢將面對更嚴重的災害。為未雨綢繆，推動跨界別、跨組織和跨專業領域的合作，是個別地區能更有效應對新冠疫情的關鍵因素。一以貫之，公益慈善團體是否應該攜手建立更具抗逆力的合作機制？

這個環節旨在探討全球公益慈善事業的協作潛力，以防止及防範未來公共衛生危機的爆發，並藉此共商應對策略。

Lincoln is President Emeritus, China Medical Board (CMB) where he served as President from 2006-2014. 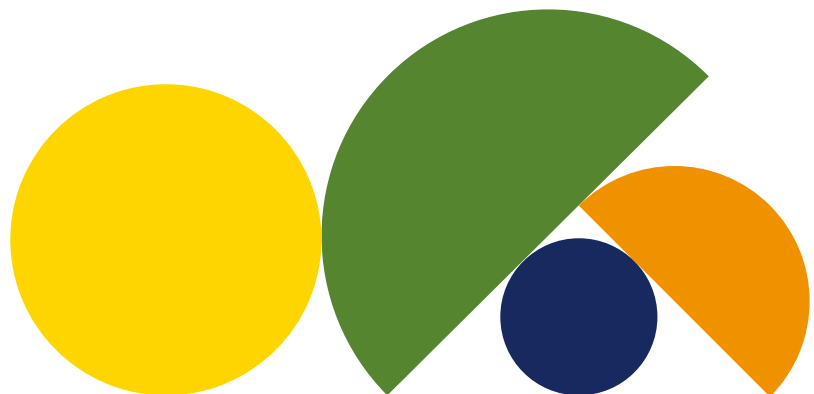

Trust-based Philanthropy is an emerging trend in philanthropic giving. It challenges power dynamics in traditional giving in which funders often place significant restriction on their funding and high degrees of reporting and verification. While this approach has freed up organisations to innovate and be flexible in their giving, there remain concerns about whether it goes too far in terms of lowering accountability and the effectiveness of grants.

The panel will debate the pros and cons of trust-based philanthropy vis-a-vis other approaches and lessons for guiding how we give in the future.

Under Dr. Wang's leadership, CPRI has become a leading philanthropy think-tank, which drives national discourse on China's social services and charitable sector. In addition to its research, CPRI also provides professional philanthropy consulting services and has completed a number of influential projects related to charity law and policy reform, child welfare, and senior citizen service systems reform.

Dr. Wang previously worked for over 22 years at China's Ministry of Civil Affairs (MOCA) where he was instrumental in launching several renowned national policies including direct village elections and the country's urban/rural minimum welfare social safety net system. Following the devastating Wenchuan earthquake, he established the National Natural Disaster Response System, a four-tiered mechanism for coordinated emergency response. While at MOCA, Dr. Wang also focused on expanding social security benefits to the country's most vulnerable, reforming the national welfare system to provide allowances and greater support to groups such as orphans and senior citizens.

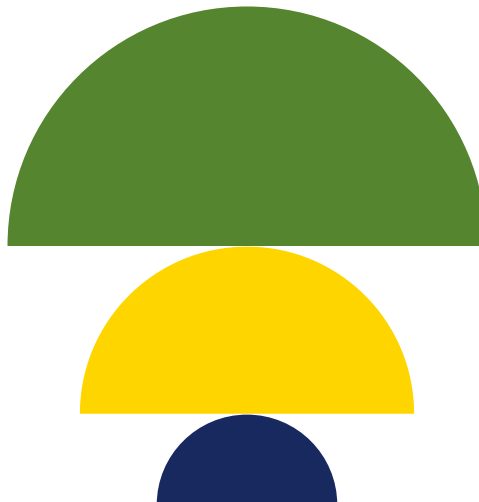

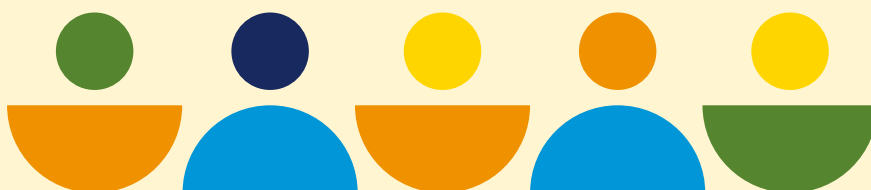
Economic marginalisation excludes sub-populations from accessing opportunities and infrastructure in cities. Differently abled individuals, ethnic minorities, women, and other groups are also more vulnerable to shocks and stresses in their communities, which we starkly witnessed during the pandemic. Decent employment opportunities are one way to build resilience and support social and economic mobility for historically marginalised groups. However, job accessibility, job insecurity, and wage discrimination are barriers we have yet to tackle systemically.

This session will examine the most pressing barriers faced by marginalised communities and explore new ways to support inclusive economic growth and job creation.

In her current role as the Executive Director for Africa and Child Health and Development, she leads strategy, continental partnerships and CIFF investment portfolios in Africa. She oversees a vast portfolio of Child Nutrition, Neglected Tropical Diseases, Water Sanitation and Hygiene, Climate and Adolescent Reproductive Health.

Faustina is a champion and advocate for women's and girls' rights and has worked to change policy on access to reproductive health services in West and East Africa. She believes in harnessing the potential of the girl child, through improved health, education, and economic opportunities to contribute to a thriving self-determining Africa. She is passionate about growing leaders and was recognised and named as top 100 influential African women in 2021.

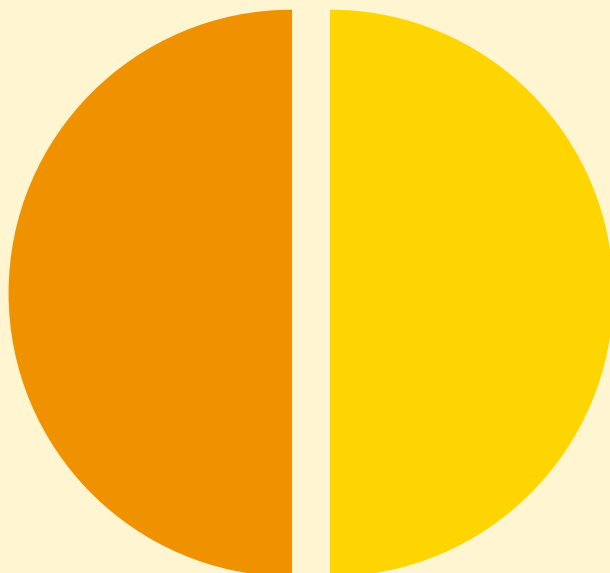
Intergenerational wealth creates huge discrepancies in the development opportunities a child receives such as access to quality education and early childhood development. A child with a weaker start suffers significant disadvantage in later life. Increased discrepancy at the starting line has been associated with declining social mobility. There is a role for philanthropy to support governments in levelling this field for all children especially during early schooling to ultimately break this intergenerational cycle of poverty.

This session will explore initiatives that have been successful in providing equal access to quality education, regardless of background, and the gaps that remain to be plugged.

Under her leadership, YCAB earned the 28th spot among the Top 100 NGOs in the World (Geneva, 2022), and Veronica herself was honored with two United Nations awards (Vienna 2001; New York 2017). She holds the titles of Asia21 Leader, World Economic Forum's Young Global Leader and Social Entrepreneur, as well as being recognized as one of Forbes' 48 Asian Philanthropists.

Additionally, Veronica serves as an Independent Commissioner for PT. PNM, the world's largest microfinance institution, and holds the position of Chairperson at AVPN (Asian Venture Philanthropy Network) — the leading social investment network in Asia, dedicated to boosting capital flow for impactful initiatives. Alongside her professional endeavors, she is a published author and an accomplished speaker, but above all, she takes immense pride in her role as a mother to three grown children.

他擁有超過30年的專業經驗，在科技營銷、廣告和策略規劃方面擔任過多個重要崗位。

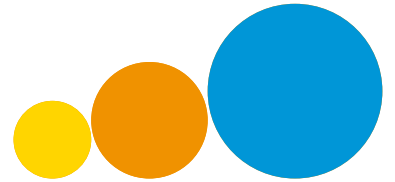

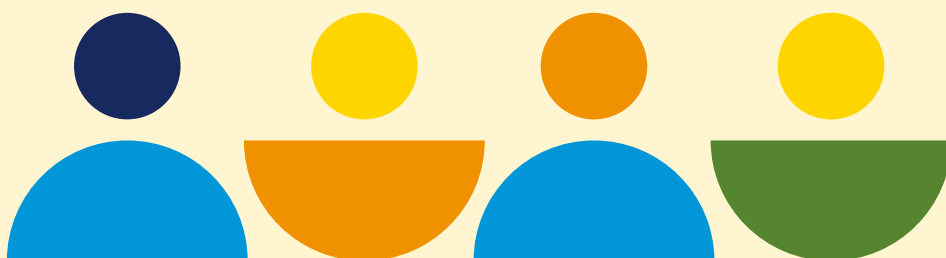

Jobs of the future will not just appear; they will need to be created. Upper and middle-income countries have achieved their economic status by not only supporting high-growth technology start-ups, but also by nurturing their local small businesses. Recent limelight has focussed either on the tech unicorn on one end or the self-employed gig entrepreneur on the other. And yet it is the mass entrepreneur, such as the local restaurant owner, who is the engine of job growth.

This session will explore the drivers of dignified jobs and how philanthropy can better enable a revival of mass entrepreneurship to drive more equitable economic growth in our urban centres.

Welfare models of nations have evolved based on their unique economic, social, and political contexts. Following the Second World War, Western Europe is seen to have taken equality at its core and anchored on the state to drive income redistribution and welfare. However, many emerging nations have largely relied on civil society and social investment to drive fairness. East Asian policies are yet linked to another model in which welfare is closely linked with productive activities and considers economic growth to be paramount. As the world re-thinks its priorities today, these models must be rehearsed and debated.

In this session, Former Prime Minister of Thailand Abhisit Vejjajiva, Nobel Laureate Professor Abhijit Banerjee, and Former Chief Economist of The World Bank Professor Justin Yifu Lin will draw on their rich experiences to help us re-imagine how welfare models could be deployed going forward and identify the models where philanthropy takes centre stage.

福利體制的發展取決於國家獨有的經濟、社會和政治環境。第二次世界大戰後，西歐國家的福利模式以平等為核心，依靠國家推動社會福利和進行收入再分配。另一邊廂，不少新興國家將實現平等的方法，很大程度訴諸於民間社會和社會投資。東亞國家政策則傾向另一種模式，認為福利與生產力密不可分，對經濟增長亦至關重要。今天，當世界重新思考各項議題的緩急先後時，便應就不同種福利模式反覆進行思辯。

這個環節當中，前泰國總理Abhisit Vejjajiva、2019諾貝爾經濟學獎得主及麻省理工學院福特基金會國際經濟學教授Abhijit Banerjee教授，及北京大學新結構經濟學研究院院長及前世界銀行首席經濟學家林毅夫教授，將分享其豐富經驗，引領我們重新思考福利模式的未來發展方向，並確定公益慈善事業在福利模式中扮演的重要角色。



Abhijit BANERJEE

2019 Nobel Laureate in Economics and Ford Foundation International Professor of Economics, Massachusetts Institute of Technology
2019諾貝爾經濟學獎得主及麻省理工學院福特基金會國際經濟學教授

Abhijit Vinayak Banerjee is the 2019 Nobel Prize in Economics recipient along with his wife, Esther Duflo, and Michael Kremer. He was educated at the University of Calcutta, Jawaharlal Nehru University and Harvard University, where he received his Ph.D in 1988.

In 2003 he founded the Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL), along with Esther Duflo and Sendhil Mullainathan, and he remains one of the lab's directors.

Abhijit Banerjee is a past president of the Bureau for the Research in the Economic Analysis of Development, a Research Associate of the NBER, a CEPR research fellow, International Research Fellow of the Kiel Institute, a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the Econometric Society, and has been a Guggenheim Fellow and an Alfred P. Sloan Fellow and a winner of the Infosys prize.

He is the author of a large number of articles and four books, including *Poor Economics*, which won the Goldman Sachs Business Book of the Year. Abhijit's newest book, co-authored with Esther Duflo, titled *Good Economics for Hard Times*, is on how economics can help us solve social and political problems of our day. He is the editor of three more books and has directed two documentary films.

He also served on the U.N. Secretary-General's High-level Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda.

Abhijit Vinayak Banerjee在2019年與妻子Esther Duflo及美國學者Michael Kremer共同獲頒諾貝爾經濟學獎。他畢業於加爾各答大學、尼赫魯大學，並在1988年獲得哈佛大學博士學位。

2003年，他與Esther Duflo及Sendhil Mullainathan共同成立Abdul Latif Jameel「扶貧行動實驗室」(J-PAL)，至今仍為實驗室主任之一。

Abhijit Banerjee曾任發展經濟分析與研究局主席、美國國家經濟研究局(NBER)以及經濟政策研究中心研究員，同時也是Kiel研究所的國際研究員，以及美國文理科學院與世界計量經濟學會院士。他亦是Guggenheim院士、Alfred P. Sloan院士，以及Infosys獎獲獎者。

他發表過不少文章，亦出版過四本書籍，其中包括榮獲高盛年度商業書籍的《窮人的經濟學》。最新與Esther Duflo合著的《艱困時代的經濟學思考》，講述經濟發展如何幫助解決現今社會和政治問題。他是另外三本書的編輯，並是兩部紀錄片的導演。

他曾擔任聯合國秘書長「2015年後發展議程」(Post-2015 Development Agenda)小組成員。





Justin Yifu LIN 林毅夫

Dean of Institute of New Structural Economics, Peking University and
Former Chief Economist, The World Bank

北京大學新結構經濟學研究院院長及前世界銀行首席經濟學家

Justin Yifu Lin is Dean of Institute of New Structural Economics, Dean of Institute of South-South Cooperation and Development and Professor and Honorary Dean of National School of Development at Peking University. He was the Senior Vice President and Chief Economist of the World Bank, 2008-2012. Prior to this, Mr. Lin served for 15 years as Founding Director and Professor of the China Centre for Economic Research (CCER) at Peking University. He is Councilor of the State Council and a member of the Standing Committee, Chinese People's Political Consultation Conference. He is the author of more than 20 books including *Justin Yifu Lin on China's Economy*, *Beating the Odds: Jump-starting Developing Countries*; *Going Beyond Aid: Development Cooperation for Structural Transformation*, *the Quest for Prosperity: How Developing Economies Can Take Off*, *New Structural Economics: A Framework for Rethinking Development and Policy*, *Against the Consensus: Reflections on the Great Recession*, and *Demystifying the Chinese Economy*. He is a Corresponding Fellow of the British Academy and a Fellow of the Academy of Sciences for Developing World.

林毅夫教授是北京大學新結構經濟學研究院教授、院長，北京大學南南合作與發展學院院長，北京大學國家發展研究院名譽院長。1994年創立北京大學中國經濟研究中心(現北京大學國家發展研究院)，並擔任主任一職。2008年被任命為世界銀行首席經濟學家兼負責發展經濟學的高級副行長，成為擔此要職的發展中國家第一人。2012年在世界銀行的任期屆滿，返回北大，繼續教學研究工作。林毅夫現任全國政協常委、經濟委員會副主任、國務院參事，曾任全國工商業聯合會專職副主席，任第七至第十屆全國政協委員、第十屆全國政協經濟委員會副主任、十一屆全國人大代表、十二、十三屆全國政協常委、經濟委員會副主任。在國內外多個有關發展政策、農業、減貧的委員會、領導小組兼職。膺選為發展中國家科學院(原第三世界科學院)院士及英國科學院外籍院士，並獲英法美加香港10所大學榮譽博士學位。主要著作：《論中國經濟》、《戰勝命運》、《超越發展援助》、《繁榮的求索》、《解讀中國經濟》、《新結構經濟學》、《從西潮到東風》、《本體與常無》、《中國的奇跡》等二十餘冊。並在國內外學術期刊發表100多篇論文。



Abhisit VEJJAJIVA

Former Prime Minister of Thailand

前泰國總理

Abhisit Vejjajiva was Thailand's 27th Prime Minister, holding the post from December 2008 to August 2011. He was first elected to Parliament in 1992 and was reelected eight times.

He had served as Government Spokesperson (1992-1994) and as a Minister Attached to the Prime Minister's Office (1997).

Over two and a half decades, he has assumed many responsibilities including Deputy Secretary General to the Prime Minister for Political Affairs; Chairman of the House Committee for Education; and as Leader of the Opposition in the House of Representatives for three terms.

He was born in Newcastle upon Tyne in the United Kingdom in 1964. After completing his primary education in Thailand, he returned to the United Kingdom to study at Eton College.

He later graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics (PPE) with 1st class Honours from Oxford University, where he also earned a Master's Degree in Economics.

Before entering politics he taught at the Chulachomkiao Royal Military Academy from 1987 to 1988 and at the Faculty of Economics, Thammasat University from 1990 to 1991.

Abhisit Vejjajiva是泰國第27任總理，任期為2008年12月至2011年8月。他在1992年首次當選國會議員，並連任8次。

他曾擔任政府發言人(1992-1994)和總理府助理部長(1997)。

在政壇25年來，他擔任多個重要崗位，包括總理政治事務副秘書長；眾議院教育委員會主席；並連任三屆眾議院反對黨領袖。

1964年出生於英國紐卡素的他，在泰國完成小學後，返回英國升學，就讀於伊頓公學。

後來，他以一等榮譽畢業於牛津大學，獲取哲學、政治和經濟學學士學位，其後再獲取經濟學碩士學位。

從政之前，他在1987至1988年在Chulachomkiao皇家軍事學院任教；1990至1991年在泰國國立法政大學經濟學院任教。

She is an Independent Non-Executive Director of CK Hutchison Holdings Limited; of Hutchison Telecommunications Hong Kong Holdings Limited; and of The Hongkong and Shanghai Hotels; and sits on the Board of Directors of the Our Hong Kong Foundation. Dr Wong formerly sat on the Board of the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited; and was the previous Non-Executive Chairman of The Hongkong Bank Foundation's Advisory Committee. She was also previously a Global Advisor to Mars, Incorporated.

Dr Wong has a distinguished record of public service. She is a former Member of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and sat as a Member of the Executive and Legislative Councils.

Dr Wong holds a B.Soc.Sc. from The University of Hong Kong; an M.S.W. from The University of Toronto; an M.Sc. from The London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE); and an M.A. and Ph.D. from The University of California, Davis. She has been awarded Honorary Doctorates from five universities and is an Honorary Fellow of the LSE.

王博士過去歷任多項重要公職，包括回歸前後分別出任行政局及行政會議成員，以及獲委任為立法局議員。

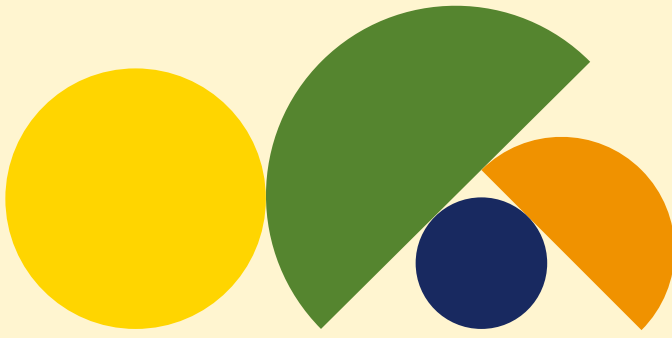

Reimagining megapolises of tomorrow to cope with climate change 未來大都市的重塑以應對氣候變化

With estimates suggesting that cities are responsible for 75% of global carbon dioxide emissions, the urgency to explore innovative approaches and strategies in urban design and planning is evident. The impact of climate change is already being felt in megapolises worldwide, with rising sea levels threatening coastal cities and extreme weather events disrupting urban life. It is imperative to address these challenges head-on and reimagine how our cities can adapt, mitigate, and thrive in the face of climate change towards long-term sustainability.

This session explores best practices, transformative ideas, and practical solutions for creating resilient and sustainable megapolises while highlighting the invaluable role of philanthropy in driving change.

Christiana FIGUERES

Co-host of “Outrage+Optimism” and Former United Nations Climate Chief
節目「Outrage+Optimism」聯合主持人及前聯合國氣候變化總幹事

Christiana Figueres is a Costa Rican citizen and was the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change 2010 – 2016.

During her tenure, Ms Figueres brought together national and sub-national governments, corporations and activists, women’s groups, scientists and spiritual communities, financial institutions and NGOs to jointly deliver the historic 2015 Paris Agreement on Climate Change. Under this Agreement, 195 sovereign governments decided on a collaborative path to limit future global warming to well below 2°C, and strive for 1.5°C in order to protect the most vulnerable in every nation. For this achievement Ms. Figueres has been credited with forging a new brand of collaborative diplomacy and received multiple awards.

Since then Ms Figueres has continued to foster rapid action on climate change. She is the co-author of *The Future We Choose, The Stubborn Optimist’s Guide to the Climate Crisis* (Penguin Random House 2019) and co-host of the popular podcast Outrage+Optimism. She sits on the Boards of ACCIONA and ACCIONA Energía.

She is a graduate of Swarthmore College and the London School of Economics and has been awarded multiple honorary doctorate degrees from academic institutions such as Yale, University of Massachusetts, Georgetown and University of Edinburgh. After decades of living and working abroad, she has moved back to her beloved Costa Rica. She has two fantastic daughters, Naima and Yihana, fountains of much joy.

Christiana Figueres 是哥斯達黎加公民，於2010年至2016年期間任《聯合國氣候變化框架公約》執行秘書。

在任期間，她召集了各地政府、企業、社會運動人士、婦女組織、科學家、宗教團體、金融機構及非政府組織等，共同達成歷史性的2015年《巴黎協定》。在協定下，195個擁有主權的政府同意將未來的全球氣溫升幅控制在攝氏2度之內，並致力將氣溫升幅限制在攝氏1.5度之內，從而保護各國的弱勢社群。因為這一成就，Figueres女士被譽為開創了新的協作外交，並屢獲殊榮。

此後，Figueres女士繼續就應對氣候變化工作促成相關行動。她是《我們可以選擇的未來：拯救氣候危機》的聯合作者，也是深受歡迎的節目「Outrage+Optimism」的聯合主持人。另外，她是ACCIONA和ACCIONA Energía的董事會成員。

Figueres女士畢業於斯沃斯莫爾學院和倫敦政治經濟學院，並獲得耶魯大學、麻省大學、喬治城大學和愛丁堡大學等學術機構頒發的多個榮譽博士學位。在外國生活及工作數十年後，她重返哥斯達黎加定居。她的兩名寶貝女兒Naima和Yihana，是她喜悅的泉源。



Amitav GHOSH

Award Winning Author (Jnanpith Award, Dan David Prize and more)

Amitav Ghosh was born in Calcutta and grew up in India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. He studied in Delhi, Oxford and Alexandria and is the author of *The Circle of Reason, The Shadow Lines, In An Antique Land, Dancing in Cambodia, The Calcutta Chromosome, The Glass Palace, The Hungry Tide, and The Ibis Trilogy*, consisting of *Sea of Poppies, River of Smoke and Flood of Fire*.

The Great Derangement: Climate Change and the Unthinkable, a work of non-fiction, appeared in 2016.

Gun Island, was released in September 2019. Ghosh’s first-ever book in verse, *Jungle Nama: A Story of the Sundarban*, was published in February 2021. His latest book, *The Nutmeg’s Curse: Parables for a Planet in Crisis*, was released in October 2021.

Amitav Ghosh 出生於印度加爾各答，成長於印度、孟加拉國和斯里蘭卡。他曾在新德里、牛津和亞歷山大求學，著有《理性的循環》、《陰影線》、《在遠古的土地上》、《在柬埔寨起舞》、《加爾各答染色體》、《玻璃宮殿》、《餓潮》和《朱鷺號三部曲》：《罌粟海》、《煙籠河》及《烽火劫》。

2016年發表非小說類作品《大混亂：氣候變化與不可思議》；2019年9月發行《Gun Island》；2021年2月出版個人首部詩集《Jungle Nama：Sundarban》。

其最新著作《肉豆蔻的詛咒》於2021年10月面世。

Mr Yau was the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government's first Secretary for Environment from 2007-2012. His environment policy portfolio covered environmental protection, energy, climate change, and sustainability. During his tenure, he took part in United Nation's Climate Change Conferences and had Hong Kong join the C40 Climate Change Initiatives sharing the belief that metropolitan cities could do much in help supporting the fight against climate change. He worked closely with the Mainland authorities in promoting the Green Pearl River Delta Area through cleaner production as well as setting regional targets for cleaner air and common environmental targets for Hong Kong and Guangdong province.

Mr Yau has extensive experience in public service as well as international affairs. Mr Yau represented Hong Kong, China at major international organisations including World Trade Organisation, Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation, OECD etc.

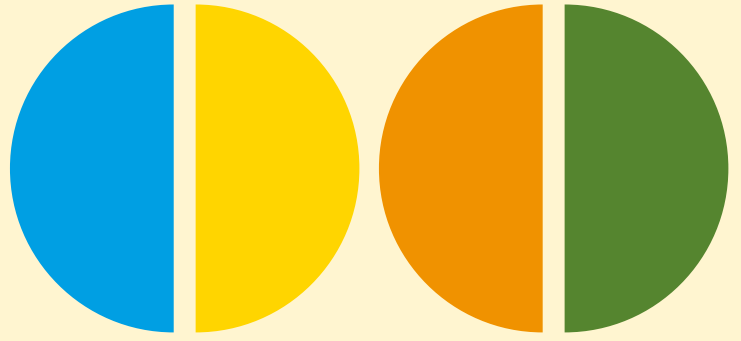
He has also secured and implemented a number of major Free Trade and Investment Agreements between Hong Kong and key trading partners. He firmly believes that Hong Kong's practice of free trade and international finance could also be effective tools in facilitating green financing and in rallying international efforts in tackling climate change.

Reducing disparities through health justice – How can philanthropies drive equitable access to healthcare?

Healthcare often reflects the deep inequalities of the world, with at least half of the world's population still unable to access essential health services. Under-5 mortality is more than 8 times higher in Africa than in Europe. While health expenditure comprises 10% of the world's GDP, reflecting a massive part of government and private spending in the sector, it often fails to drive innovation towards serving the most disadvantaged. This is where philanthropy can take its precious few dollars and catalyse the larger flow of capital towards more equitable outcomes.

This session will look at past examples where philanthropy has filled underfunded gaps. This includes recent learnings from the pandemic such as equitable vaccine distribution and safeguarding migrant workers. The panel will draw on these examples to guide how philanthropy can operate going forward.

醫療衛生往往反映了全球資源分配嚴重不均的狀況，世界各地至少有一半人口仍無法享用基本衛生服務，非洲的5歲以下兒童死亡數字比歐洲高逾八倍。雖然醫衛支出佔全球國內生產總值的一成，反映政府和私營機構投放大量資源在該領域上，但仍然常常無法開創改革，以照顧最急需照顧的弱勢社群。公益慈善事業正可在這樣情況下利用珍貴的捐款，促進更大規模的資金流入，推動醫衛公平。

這個環節將會檢視公益慈善事業在過去如何填補資金缺口的實例，例如全球爆發大流行疾病期間，如何公平分配疫苗和保護移民工人。講者們會借鏡上述例子，探索公益慈善事業未來的運作模式。



Sudhir ANAND

Centennial and Visiting Professor, International Inequalities Institute,
London School of Economics and Political Science
倫敦政治經濟學院國際不平等研究所百年紀念及客座教授

Sudhir Anand is an economist who works on inequality, development, and health. He has published widely in the areas of income inequality and poverty; undernutrition; human development; health equity; population ethics; health metrics; health inequalities; human resources for health; and other topics in economics and in health. Anand is also Emeritus Professor of Economics at the University of Oxford, and Emeritus Fellow of St Catherine's College, Oxford, as well as Visiting Professor at the Harvard Medical School and Associate of the Asia Center at Harvard.

In the past thirty years he has held a succession of positions at Harvard University, including: Visiting and Adjunct Professor at the Harvard School of Public Health; Visiting Professor of Global Health and Social Medicine at the Harvard Medical School; Visiting Professor of Public Policy at the Harvard Kennedy School; Acting Director of the Harvard Center for Population and Development Studies; and Research Director of the Global Equity Initiative at Harvard.

Anand chaired the WHO Scientific Peer Review Group on health systems performance assessment. He has been keynote speaker at many recent international conferences on global health, inequality, and development. In 2016 he was elected a Member of the US National Academy of Medicine, which is part of the US National Academy of Sciences. Sudhir Anand received his MA in mathematics and B.Phil. and D.Phil. in economics from the University of Oxford.

Sudhir Anand 是一位致力研究不平等、發展和健康議題的經濟學家。他在多個領域發表大量著作，涵蓋貧富差距、貧困、營養不良、人類發展、醫衛公平、人口倫理學、健康指標、醫衛不平等、衛生人力資源；以及其他經濟和健康議題。Anand 亦是牛津大學榮休教授；牛津大學聖凱瑟琳學院榮譽院士、哈佛醫學院客座教授和哈佛大學亞洲中心副教授。

過去30年，他在哈佛大學擔任一系列職務，包括：哈佛大學公共衛生學院客座教授；哈佛醫學院全球衛生與社會醫學客座教授；哈佛大學甘迺迪學院公共政策客座教授；哈佛大學人口與發展研究中心署理總監；哈佛大學全球平等倡議研究主任。

Anand 曾任世界衛生組織衛生系統績效評估專家同行評議組主席。他近年獲邀出席多個國際會議任主題演講嘉賓，就全球衛生、不平等和發展等議題發表演說。2016年，他當選為美國國家醫學院院士，該學院隸屬美國國家科學院。Sudhir Anand 持有牛津大學數學碩士學位、經濟學哲學學士及哲學博士學位。



Somsak CHUNHARAS

President, National Health Foundation of Thailand
泰國國家衛生基金會會長

Somsak Chunharas is a medical doctor and is President of the National Health Foundation and Thai Geriatric Research Institute, two Thai NGOs providing platforms for evidence-based policy development in Thailand. Graduated from Ramathibodi Medical School, Mahidol University, Chunharas then obtained an MPH from Royal Tropical Institute, the Netherlands.

He started working in 1978 as a practicing physician and director of community hospitals in rural Thailand; went on to international health and health planning and was appointed as deputy minister of health in 2015. He initiated health economics capacity building in Thailand in 1985 and became Founding Director of Thai Health Systems Research Institute in 1992. He was the team manager on Thai research system reform study in 2007, a crucial input for the present research systems reform in 2019. He also served as a member of policy monitoring and support group on PHC development, Thai MOPH in 2020.

Chunharas has worked with WHO, UNICEF and other global organizations in health systems and health research. He was a member of the Global Advisory Committee on Health Research (ACHR) of WHO HQ and two other regional ACHRs. He was a board member of the Council on Health Research and Development (COHRED) and Alliance for Health Policy and System Research (APHSR). He was the expert resource person of the ministerial leadership programme of Harvard Kennedy School and School of Public Health from 2014 to 2016. He was also invited to be Menschel Senior Leadership fellow at Harvard School of Public Health in 2017.

Somsak Chunharas 是一名醫生，並擔任兩個泰國非政府組織的主席，分別是泰國國家衛生基金會及泰國老年醫學研究所，為泰國提供實證為本的平台推動政策發展。

畢業於Mahidol大學Ramathibodi醫學院，及後再獲荷蘭皇家熱帶研究院公共衛生學碩士學位。1978年開始執業，在泰國農村醫院擔任醫生和主任；其後研究國際衛生及衛生規劃，於2015年獲委任為衛生部副部長。他自1985年起，致力推動泰國發展衛生經濟學之潛力，1992年成立泰國衛生系統研究所。他曾在2007年帶領團隊研究系統改革，該研究為2019年沿用至今的研究系統改革提供了重要依據。他在2020年擔任泰國公共衛生部基層醫療發展政策監督和支持小組成員。

Abhisit Vejjajiva was Thailand's 27th Prime Minister, holding the post from December 2008 to August 2011. He was first elected to Parliament in 1992 and was reelected eight times.

He had served as Government Spokesperson (1992-1994) and as a Minister Attached to the Prime Minister's Office (1997).

Over two and a half decades, he has assumed many responsibilities including Deputy Secretary General to the Prime Minister for Political Affairs; Chairman of the House Committee for Education; and as Leader of the Opposition in the House of Representatives for three terms.

He was born in Newcastle upon Tyne in the United Kingdom in 1964. After completing his primary education in Thailand, he returned to the United Kingdom to study at Eton College.

He later graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics (PPE) with 1st class Honours from Oxford University, where he also earned a Master's Degree in Economics.

Before entering politics he taught at the Chulachomkiao Royal Military Academy from 1987 to 1988 and at the Faculty of Economics, Thammasat University from 1990 to 1991.

Abhisit Vejjajiva是泰國第27任總理，任期為2008年12月至2011年8月。他在1992年首次當選國會議員，並連任8次。

他曾擔任政府發言人(1992-1994)和總理府助理部長(1997)。

She is trained as an anaesthesiologist in Queen Mary Hospital. In 2008, she started her career in administration as the Head of the Patient Safety and Risk Management Department in the Hospital Authority administration. She then worked in the Division of Strategy and Planning for public healthcare services development since 2011. In 2015, she also took up the position of Deputizing Hospital Chief Executive of the Buddhist Hospital, overseeing the operations of the hospital as well as its refurbishment works.

Population growth in cities along with recent pandemic shocks have created an unaffordability crisis, forcing 1.6 billion people worldwide into homelessness or to reside in substandard living environments. These groups will lack access to improved water, sanitation, and sufficient living space, while also lacking security of tenure. City leaders need to ensure access to infrastructure and public spaces. But they must also think about what role these public spaces could play in bridging gaps between the various demographic groups that reside within their borders.

This session will spotlight successful public housing case studies and discuss innovative approaches that could ensure every individual has equal access to basic services that allow a dignified quality of life.

Professor Sock-Yong Phang is the Celia Moh Chair Professor of Economics at the Singapore Management University. She obtained her PhD in Economics from Harvard University in 1989. She researches in the areas of housing, transportation, and infrastructure economics, focusing on the role and impacts of government policies in these sectors.

She is author of the following books: *Policy Innovations for Affordable Housing in Singapore: From Colony to Global City* (2018); *Housing Finance Systems: Market Failures and Government Failures* (2013); and *Housing Markets and Urban Transportation* (1992). She has also published numerous book chapters and journal articles on housing, transport, economic regulation, and infrastructure public-private partnerships.

Professor Phang is the programme director for the "Growing Infrastructure Course – Enabling & Structuring for Private Sector Participation in Finance and Innovation", a capacity-building initiative of the Singapore government and The World Bank Group, with Singapore Management University as academic partner. The course equips regional government officials with knowledge and skills to enable sustainable and resilient infrastructure development for the region's long-term economic growth. Professor Phang has served as consultant to the World Bank, the Asian Development Bank, and various government organizations in Asia on projects involving land, housing, and infrastructure policies. In Singapore, she has previously served as board member of the Urban Redevelopment Authority, the Land Transport Authority, the Public Transport Council, the Competition and Consumer Commission, and the Energy Market Authority.

He is the principal investigator of a European Research Council (ERC) Advanced Grant – Rethinking China's Model of Governance.

Embracing an ageing society 高齡友善社會

There is a widening gap between demand and supply for elderly care. Ageing populations are rising sharply. More than half of the world's population aged 65+ will be from Asia by 2025, and individuals that require long-term care for not only chronic diseases but also for sustaining daily activities are also forecasted to quadruple by 2050, creating demand for in-home medical services. An expanding middle class and rising health awareness are adding to the pressure.

This session will explore the opportunities for and challenges in tackling ageing society, such as scaling up home care nursing across the Asia-Pacific countries, and discuss areas where philanthropy should plug in.

安老服務的供求存在巨大落差，高齡人口急劇上升，屆2025年，全球過半數以上的65歲以上人口將會來自亞洲。因患上慢性疾病以及為支撐日常起居生活，而需要長期照顧的人士，預計至2050年會增加四倍，帶動對居家醫療服務的需求。中產階級日漸壯大，加上整體健康意識提升，也加劇對有關服務的需求。

Poor mental health is a sizeable issue globally, with one in eight people already living with a mental disorder. Its incidence is also rising rapidly in the current economic, environment, and pandemic contexts, but has remained largely ignored until now. Conversations around mental wellbeing are starting but like many health challenges, its prevalence and access to treatments and support is skewed. Children and young people who have learning disabilities are three times more likely than average to have a mental health issue, yet most of this group has never had any contact with mental health services.

This session aims to examine the exacerbated barriers faced by communities to access mental health support, and discuss how philanthropies can champion its advancement.

全球精神健康問題不容忽視，每八人就有二人正與精神健康疾病共存。發病率在目前的經濟、環境和疫情下急速上升，但大部分情況仍被忽視。關於精神健康的討論已經開始一段時間，但與許多健康問題一樣，精神健康的普遍程度與能夠獲得治療及相關支援有一定落差。有學習障礙的兒童和青少年，出現精神健康問題的可能性是一般人的三倍，但他們大多數都未曾接受過任何精神健康服務。

這個環節旨在研究有關社群在獲取精神健康支援所面對的問題，並討論公益慈善事業如何推動其發展。

As part of the WPA programme, Dinesh Bhugra led and helped craft 20 Position Statements on various topics some of which influenced policy in governments around the world. He established Presidential task Forces on Child abuse and Neglect, Inter-personal Violence, Prisoner mental Health care, Migrant health care, LGBT populations' mental health care and those of people with intellectual disabilities. He established 6 WPA Collaborating centres. He developed the Bill of Rights for Individuals with mental illness signed by 60 national and international organisations.

He has authored/co-authored over 500 scientific papers, chapters, editorials and 40 books. Three of his books have been translated into Mandarin and Japanese and various books have won awards including Oxford Textbook for Public Mental Health which was BMA Book of the Year in psychiatry in 2019. On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of the NHS, "Conversations about the NHS" was published in July 2023 along with "Psychiatrists on Psychiatry" published by Oxford University Press.

He is on the Board of Sane and Psychiatric Research Trust charities and Patron of an educational charity Care-If. Between 2019-2022 he chaired the DocHealth charity which provides psychotherapy to doctors and medical students. He is a Non-Executive Director of Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust.

Dinesh Bhugra曾帶領世界精神醫學會(WPA)制定20份不同議題的立場聲明，部份聲明為各地政府政策帶來重要影響。在擔任WPA主席期間，他成立多個特別專案小組，包括關注兒童虐待和疏忽照顧、人際暴力、以及囚犯、移民、LGBT及智障人士的精神健康護理。他又成立六個世界精神醫學會合作中心，並制定《精神病患者個人權利法案》，共獲60個國家及國際組織簽署支持。

他撰寫及合著超過500篇科研論文、章節、社論和40本書籍，當中三部著作被翻譯成中文和日文，多部作品獲獎，其中牛津公共精神健康教科書於2019年獲頒英國醫學會(BMA)精神醫學年度書籍獎。今年，亦即NHS的75週年，他編輯的《Psychiatrists on Psychiatry》由牛津大學出版社出版，而他的著作《Conversations about the NHS》亦於同月(7月)出版。

他兼任慈善機構Sane及Psychiatric Research信託基金的董事局成員，也是教育慈善機構Care-If的贊助人。2019至2022年期間，他擔任慈善機構DocHealth主席，該機構為醫生和醫學學生提供心理治療。他是Sussex Partnership NHS 基金會非執行董事。

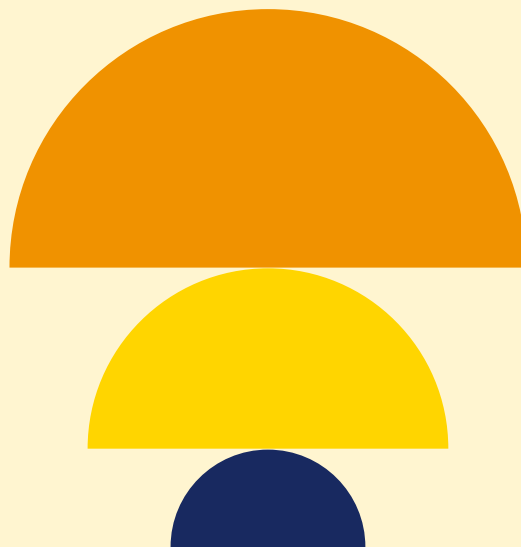

In 2020, Nathan founded the Fundraising.AI collaboration with a focus on the responsible use of AI in the non-profit sector.

Nathan is a member of the Forbes Nonprofit Council and holds a Masters in Nonprofit Administration from University of Notre Dame, an MBA from University of Redlands, a certificate in International Economics from University of Cambridge and a certificate in artificial intelligence from MIT.

Robert Kirkpatrick is a social innovator working at the intersection of emerging technology, public policy, and social change. He is a seasoned practitioner and thought leader on responsible use of big data and artificial intelligence for managing risks related to sustainable development, humanitarian action and peace and is widely recognized for starting the global movement known as data philanthropy.

In 2010, Robert became the founding Executive Director of UN Global Pulse, the United Nations Secretary-General's innovation lab and led the program for 12 years. He built the first data science team at the UN, brokered global public/private partnerships, implemented more than 80 solutions for UN agencies and national institutions in dozens of countries, led development of UN's first policy instrument on privacy and data protection for the digital age, played a key role in shaping the UN's stance on the role of big data and AI in the achievement of the SDGs, risk management and crisis prevention, oversaw the creation of the UN Futures Lab and the COVID19 Crisis Insights Team, and was appointed to serve as a Commissioner on the UN Broadband Commission.

Prior to joining the UN, Robert served as the founding CTO of Google's public health and disaster technology nonprofit, InSTEDD, co-founded and served as technical lead for the Humanitarian Systems Team at Microsoft, and was an early employee at two software start-ups.

His current interests include risk management, conflict prevention, data governance, trustworthy AI, digital human rights, and our decentralized future.

Shifting power from grantees and their communities as beneficiaries to decision-makers is an increasing area of focus over the last decade. But there are no clear rules on how to employ participatory grant-making in various contexts while avoiding the pitfalls of tokenistic engagement. Challenging traditional power dynamics and empowering grantees and communities as agents of change is also at the bedrock of the global movement towards localisation.

In this discussion, we explore case studies and examples of what-works-when in the context of participatory grant-making.

He also serves as the director and supervisor of China Charities Aid Foundation for Children, China Women's Development Foundation and Amway Charity Foundation. He also serves as the standing committee member of Beijing Social Science Association, the vice president of Capital Charity Federation and Beijing Charity Association and other social positions.

The largest intergenerational wealth transfer in history is just beginning. Amounting to nearly \$40 trillion in wealth, it poses an opportunity to make the next generation of donors more significant than ever.

The future of work faces significant disruptions and discontinuities from emerging technologies and changing cultural expectations.

AI is estimated to replace 25% of all jobs as we currently know them. Our expectations from the workplace are also evolving. Changes in industrial structures have also created flexible gig economies but these jobs bring both opportunity and instability.

The future of work will need to contend with not only job creation and losses but also how job opportunities are distributed and their ability to drive social mobility.

This session will examine the latest trends in the changing nature of work and explore the role of philanthropy in pushing us to a more just transition.

Prof Harry Shum is a world-renowned authority on computer science. Before taking up the role of Council Chairman of HKUST, Prof Shum had spent 23 years at Microsoft, where he made significant strides in artificial intelligence (AI) research and development (R&D), and successfully transformed his pioneering research into applications that changed people's lives.

After earning a PhD in Robotics from Carnegie Mellon University in 1996, Prof. Shum joined Microsoft Research US as a researcher and eventually rose through the ranks to become the Executive Vice President of Microsoft's Artificial Intelligence and Research Group. During his career with the company, he established Microsoft Research Asia as a globally leading research laboratory, and leveraged cutting-edge AI advances to significantly improve the performance of the search engine Bing. He also played a pivotal role in driving the company's overall AI strategy and R&D efforts across infrastructure, services, apps, and agents.

Prof Shum's groundbreaking research and unparalleled expertise in computer science have been widely recognized with numerous prestigious honors, including Fellowships of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and the Association for Computing Machinery. He was also elected as a Foreign Member of the US National Academy of Engineering and an International Fellow of the UK's Royal Academy Society of Engineering. Prof Shum holds more than 50 US patents. His active engagement in academic research is demonstrated through the presentation and publication of over 250 papers at international conferences or in academic journals.

Disability Sport and Inclusion Specialist, International Committee of the Red Cross

Jess Markt is the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) Disability Sport and Inclusion Specialist, leading the organization's efforts to create sustainable programs focused on breaking down the stigma of physical disability in countries dealing with the effects of war and conflict.

He has worked with the ICRC Physical Rehabilitation Programme since 2011 to build and develop wheelchair basketball and other disability sport programs in over 20 conflict zones worldwide.

In addition, Jess oversees the ICRC's efforts to stimulate economic integration opportunities for persons with physical disabilities. He has served as ICRC's speaker at international events including the UN General Assembly and the Paralympic Games.

Jess holds a bachelor's degree in English Literature from the University of Oregon, where he was a member of its world-renowned track and field team before a car accident rendered him a paraplegic in 1996. In 2019, he was named the AidEx Humanitarian Hero of the Year.

Mauritian jockey Karis Teetan was a fixture in the top 10 of the South African Jockeys' Championship by the time he left for Hong Kong in 2013. He entered the South African Jockey Academy at the age of 14 and went on to be crowned South African Champion Apprentice in 2008.

Teetan notched an impressive 50 wins in his first Hong Kong campaign, and has continued to build on that good start from season to season. He secured his first Hong Kong Group 1 win aboard Mr Stunning in the Hong Kong Sprint during the 2018/19 season, and enjoyed an even better 2019/20 campaign, registering a personal best 93 wins.

Teetan rubber-stamped his credentials in winning the LONGINES International Jockeys' Championship in 2019.

Throughout the 2021/22 Four-Year-Old Classic Series, Teetan established an impressive partnership with middle-distance star Romantic Warrior, aboard whom he claimed the Hong Kong Classic Mile and the BMW Hong Kong Derby.

Teetan also tasted success in the QEII Cup in partnership with that horse. Teetan extended his record to 500 Hong Kong wins in January, 2022. But, he never stops to strive for the next level of achievement.

毛里裘斯籍的田泰安，是現任香港騎師。他於十四歲時進入南非騎師學院習騎，於2008年榮膺南非冠軍見習騎師。其後於2013年來港發展，當時已穩居南非騎師榜的前十名。他來港後首季即贏得五十場頭馬，成績驕人，其後亦持續有好表現。在2018/2019年度馬季，他夥拍「紅衣醒神」攻下香港短途錦標，在香港打開一級賽勝利之門。而在2019/2020年度馬季，他的表現更進一步，共取得九十三場頭馬，刷新來港後個人最佳成績。他更於同一馬季贏得浪琴國際騎師錦標賽冠軍，實至名歸。2021/2022年度馬季，田泰安收穫頗豐，當中包括策騎「浪漫勇士」勝出女皇杯，增添他在港的一級賽頭馬進賬，他亦夥拍此駒攻下香港打吡大賽及香港經典一哩賽。田泰安至今仍努力刷新個人紀錄，突破表現。

Dr Trisha Leahy, [PhD (Psychology), JD (Law); SBS, BBS] is the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Sports Institute, the HKSAR Government's designated organisation delivering Hong Kong's elite sports systems.

Known for her expertise in governance, and gender equity issues, Dr Leahy has been a Board/Committee member of numerous Non-Governmental Organisations; professional bodies; in the school and University sector; public statutory and advisory bodies.

She was a Member of a UNICEF expert panel (2007-2009) advising on global research and policy strategies on the prevention of harassment and abuse in sport; and a Member of the International Olympic Medical Commission's expert committee (2007-2015) which produced the International Olympic Committee's influential Consensus Statement on the same issue. She was a member of the founding group, and first Co-chair of Safe Sport International, and an Advisory Board Member until 2020.

She was awarded the Bronze Bauhinia Star (BBS) in 2014 and the Silver Bauhinia Star (SBS) in 2020 by the HKSAR Government.

她於2014年獲香港特別行政區政府頒授銅紫荊星章(BBS)，及後在2020年獲頒銀紫荊星章(SBS)。



Ke Huy QUAN 關繼威

Academy Award-winner
奧斯卡金像獎得主

Ke Huy Quan is an Academy Award winning actor, after making his triumphant return to the big screen starring in *Everything Everywhere All At Once*. *Everything Everywhere All At Once* was the most decorated film at the 95th Oscars, with a staggering eleven nominations and seven wins, including Best Picture. In addition to the Academy Award, this performance garnered Ke a Golden Globe Award, Critics Choice Film Award, Independent Spirit Award, Hollywood Critics Association Award, and a Gotham Award for Outstanding Supporting Performance. Ke also made history being the first Asian male to win a SAG Award in the Best Supporting Actor Category for film.

Recently in television, Ke was seen in the Disney+ series *American Born Chinese* as series regular “Freddy Wong”, opposite Daniel Wu and Michelle Yeoh and will next be seen in the highly anticipated second season of Marvel’s Emmy-nominated series *Loki* for Disney+, set to air October 6, 2023.

Ke’s first acting role was directly opposite Harrison Ford and Kate Capshaw in Steven Spielberg and Paramount Pictures’ *Indiana Jones And The Temple Of Doom*. Following his feature debut, he went on to play “Data” opposite Josh Brolin, Martha Plimpton, and Sean Astin in the beloved Warner Bros’ adventure comedy, *The Goonies*.

Following the momentum of his early acting career, Ke took some time to work extensively on the development and directing side of multiple film projects in Asia, including several projects for filmmaker Wong Kar Wai. He has extensive martial arts training and has worked as a stunt choreographer for the *X-Men* feature film and Columbia Pictures’ *The One*.

Ke is trilingual and fluent in Cantonese, Mandarin and English and currently resides in Los Angeles.

關繼威重返幕前後，憑藉參演的電影《奇異女俠玩救宇宙》(Everything Everywhere All At Once) 贏得奧斯卡金像獎。《奇異女俠玩救宇宙》在第95屆奧斯卡金像獎獲得11項提名，最終奪得7項獎項，包括最佳電影，成為大贏家。除了奧斯卡金像獎外，關繼威更憑藉精湛演技橫掃金球獎、影評人選擇大獎、獨立精神獎、荷里活影評人協會獎和葛咸電影頒獎禮最佳男配角。他亦締造歷史，成為史上首位榮獲美國演員工會獎(SAG Award)最佳男配角的亞裔男演員。

關繼威近期接拍了多齣電視劇，包括在Disney+上架的美劇《西遊ABC》(American Born Chinese) 中飾演「Freddy Wong」，與吳彥祖和楊紫瓊有對手戲。他亦將會在萬眾期待的Disney+劇集《洛基》(Loki)第二季中亮相，而該劇曾獲得艾美獎提名，第二季將於今年10月6日播出。

關繼威的首個演出角色，是史提芬史匹堡執導、派拉蒙影業(Paramount Pictures)發行的《奪寶奇兵：魔域奇兵》，與夏里遜福(Harrison Ford)及凱特卡普肖(Kate Capshaw)有不少對手戲。在首部電影亮相之後，他與佐斯布連(Josh Brolin)、瑪莎普林頓(Martha Plimpton)、辛艾斯汀(Sean Astin)等人，合演華納兄弟的探險喜劇《七寶奇謀》，並飾演「Data」一角。

早期演藝生涯走紅後，關繼威曾從事幕後工作，負責亞洲多個電影項目的策劃和導演工作，其中數項更與著名電影人王家衛合作。他有著深厚的武術訓練根基，並曾擔任《X戰警》和哥倫比亞影業(Columbia Pictures)發行之《救世主》的武術指導。

關繼威目前居於洛杉磯，精通三種語言，分別是粵語、國語及英語。

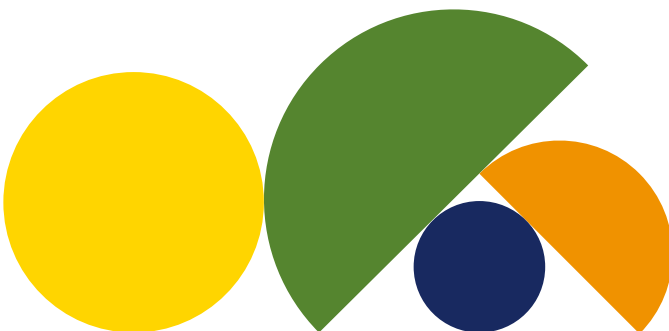

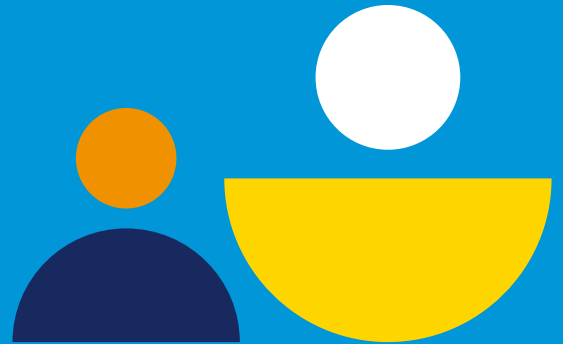
